ENROLMENT POLICY

INTRODUCTION

West Coast Calisthenics Club believes it is necessary to have an enrolment policy to make it fair and equitable for all clubs in the Calisthenics Association of Western Australia (CAWA) competitions.

1. WHAT IS THE PURPOSE OF THIS POLICY?

- The purpose of this Policy is to provide guidelines for those persons wishing to join the West Coast Calisthenics Club.

2. WHO DOES THIS POLICY APPLY TO?

- This Policy applies to all persons wishing to join the West Coast Calisthenics Club.

3. WHAT IS THE STATUS OF THIS POLICY?

- This Policy comes into force on August 31st 2011 and is reviewed annually.
- This Policy may be subject to change at the discretion of the West Coast Calisthenics Club Committee.

POSITION STATEMENT

We believe there is a need to have an enrolment policy that is fair and equitable to all persons wishing to join the West Coast Calisthenics Club.

Our Club appreciates the need to promote and protect all clubs in the CAWA competition.

We believe we should help to protect and support new and existing clubs.

When our classes are full, applicants will be referred to neighbouring clubs.

We will encourage applicants to remain at their current club before consideration is given to transfer requests. This makes for a more competitive and fair competition.

RESPONSIBILITIES UNDER THE POLICY

- West Coast Calisthenics Club Committee members must adopt and comply with this Policy; and publish, distribute and promote this Policy (and any amendments made to it from time to time) to their members and make this Policy available for inspection.

OPERATIONAL PROCEDURES

- Class numbers will be adhered to as set by the Head Coach and agreed by the committee. (It must be noted that these recommendations will depend on the availability of coaching staff and availability of training venues, therefore may be subject to change).
- Class numbers will be set at the end of term three for the following year.

NEW MEMBERS

- Potential new members are required to contact the club Registrar to check on class availability before attending their first free class. The Registrar's contact number will be on the West Coast Calisthenics Club website.
- Applications for new members after term one will be at the discretion of the Head Coach in consultation with the team coach.

TRANSFERS

- Applicants wishing to transfer from other clubs will be asked to speak with their current club and encouraged to stay if possible.
- Applicants at all times must seek transfer approval from the West Coast Head Coach and the West Coast Executive Committee.
- All transfers into Junior, Intermediate and Senior classes will need to be considered by the Head Coach and executive committee.
- Transfers into Seniors will only be considered where:
 - a) The applicant is a returning West Coast member.
 - b) The applicant is from a club where NO senior team exists.
- Extenuating circumstances will be taken into consideration.
- Transfers should be applied for in Term 4.
- Applications applied for and accepted after team selection (please note that some teams are selected in term 4) will be placed in the last team of that section.

PRIORITY MEMBERSHIPS (To be used in the event of limited vacancies)

- Siblings of current members.
- Returning West Coast members with 12 months or less absence.
- Transfers from clubs where age section is unavailable.

LATE APPLICATIONS

- Applications applied for and accepted after team selections will be placed in the last team of that section.
